

**UIL Eligibility Rules (No Pass, No Play)**  
**The CFBISD Compliance Schedule 2024-2025 School Year**  
**Academic Grading Periods for Extracurricular Programs**

- August 12, Mon. - School Begins
- All students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits are eligible. These requirements are:
    - Jr. High – student promoted from previous grade
    - Soph – student has earned five (5) credits
    - Junior – student has earned 10 credits or earned five the previous year
    - Senior – student has earned 15 credits or earned five the previous year

**MAKE SURE THE CREDITS ARE TOWARD STATE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- September 20, Fri. - End of First Six Weeks
- All grades must be checked.
- Sept. 20 – Sept. 27 - Grace Period – Students who failed a class are still eligible.
- Sept. 27, Fri. - At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on Sept 20 becomes ineligible for the remainder of first grading period.
- October 11, Fri. - End of first grading period (9 Weeks)
- All grades must be checked
- Oct. 11 – Oct. 21 - Fall Break: From the end of the school day on the 11<sup>th</sup> until school begins on the 21<sup>st</sup>, all students are **ACADEMICALLY** eligible to participate.
- Oct. 21 - Oct. 28 - Grace period for those who fail a subject and a waiting period for those who become eligible at the end of the first grading period.
- October 28, Mon. - Students failing any course on October 11 become ineligible at the beginning of the school day. Students previously ineligible become eligible if they passed all subjects.
- November 8, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Nov. 8 – Nov. 15 - Waiting period
- November 15, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of November 8 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- Nov. 22 – Dec. 2 - From the end of the school day on November 22 until the start of the school day on December 2, all students are **ACADEMICALLY** eligible to participate.
- December 6, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Dec. 6 – Dec. 13 - Waiting period
- December 13, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of December 6 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- December 20, Fri. - End of second grading period (8 Weeks)

- Dec. 20 – Jan. 7 - Winter Break: All students are ACADEMICALLY eligible to participate from Dec. 20 at the end of the school day until the start of the school day on Tuesday, January 7, 2025.
- Jan. 7 – Jan. 14 - Grace period for those who fail a subject on Dec 20 and a waiting period for those who become eligible at the end of the second grading period.
- January 14, Tues. - Ineligibility begins at the end of the school day or eligibility is regained.
- January 27, Mon. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Jan. 27 – Feb. 3 - Waiting Period
- Feb. 3, Mon. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of Jan 27 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- February 18, Tues. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Feb. 18 – Feb. 25 - Waiting period.
- Feb. 25, Tues. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of February 18 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- March 7, Fri. - End of third grading period (9 Weeks)  
  - All grades must be checked
- Mar. 7 – Mar. 14 - Waiting period.
- Mar. 14 – Mar. 24 - Spring Break: From the end of the school day on the 14<sup>th</sup> until school begins on the 24<sup>th</sup>, all students are ACADEMICALLY eligible to participate.
- March 24, Mon. - Students failing any course on March 7 become ineligible at the beginning of the school day. Students previously ineligible become eligible if they passed all subjects.
- April 4, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Apr. 4 – Apr. 11 - Waiting period.
- April 11, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of April 4 become eligible at the end of the regular time of the school day.
- April 25, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for the ineligible students.
- April 25 – May 2 - Waiting period.
- May 2, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of April 25 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- May 22, Thurs. - Last day of school. End of the fourth grading period. Students with the correct number of credits will be eligible when school begins in the fall. Those needing additional credits may earn these during the summer.
