

**UIL Eligibility Rules (No Pass, No Play)**  
**The C-FB ISD Compliance Schedule 2019-2020 School Year**  
**Academic Grading Periods for Extracurricular Programs**

- August 19, Mon. - School Begins
- All students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits are eligible. These requirements are:
    - Jr. High – student promoted from previous grade
    - Soph – student has earned five (5) credits
    - Junior – student has earned 10 credits or earned five the previous year
    - Senior – student has earned 15 credits or earned five the previous year

**MAKE SURE THE CREDITS ARE TOWARD STATE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- September 27, Fri. - End of First Six Weeks
- All grades must be checked.
- Sept. 27 - Oct. 4 - Grace Period – Students who failed a class are still eligible.
- October 4, Fri. - At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on Sept 27 becomes ineligible for the remainder of first grading period.
- October 10, Thurs. - End of first grading period
- All grades must be checked
- Oct. 10- Oct. 17 - Grace period for those who fail a subject and a waiting period for those who become eligible at the end of the first grading period.
- October 17, Thurs. - Students failing any course on October 17 becomes ineligible at the end of the school day. Students previously ineligible become eligible if they passed all subjects.
- November 1, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Nov. 1 – Nov. 8 - Waiting period
- November 8, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of November 1 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- Nov. 22 – Dec 2 - From the time the bell rings on November 22 until the start of the school day on Dec 2 all students are **ACADEMICALLY** eligible to participate.
- November 22, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Dec. 2 – Dec. 9 - Waiting period
- December 9, Mon. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of November 22 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- December 20, Fri. - End of second grading period
- Dec. 20 – Jan. 7 - All students are **ACADEMICALLY** eligible to participate from Dec 20 at the end of the school day until the start of the school day on Tues. Jan 7, 2020.

- Jan. 7 – Jan. 14 - Grace period for those who fail a subject on Dec 20 and a waiting period for those who become eligible at the end of the second grading period.
- January 14, Tues. - Ineligibility begins at the end of the school day or eligibility is regained.
- January 27, Mon. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Jan. 27 – Feb. 3 - Waiting Period
- Feb. 3, Mon. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of Jan 27 become eligible at the end of the school day.
- February 18, Tues. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students.
- Feb. 18 – Feb. 25 - Waiting period.
- Feb. 25, Tues. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of February 18<sup>th</sup> become eligible at the end of the school day.
- Mar. 6 – Mar. 16 - From the time the bell rings on the 6<sup>th</sup> to dismiss kids for spring break until school begins on the 16<sup>th</sup> all students are ACADEMICALLY eligible to participate.
- March 20, Fri. - End of third grading period
- All grades must be checked
- Mar. 20 – Mar. 27 - Waiting period.
- March 27, Fri. - Students failing any course on March 20<sup>th</sup> become ineligible at the end of the regular time of the school day. Student's regaining eligibility become eligible at the end of the regular time of the school day.
- \*April 9, Thurs. - Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students. \* If school is in session on Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup> (Bad Weather Day), then this date will move to Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup> instead of Thursday, April 9<sup>th</sup>.
- \*Apr. 9 – Apr. 16 - Waiting period. \*If school is in session on Fri, April 10<sup>th</sup> then the waiting period becomes April 10<sup>th</sup> – April 17<sup>th</sup>.
- \*April 16, Thurs. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of April 9<sup>th</sup> become eligible at the end of the regular time of the school day. If school is in session on Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, then students would become eligible at the end of the regular time of the school day on Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup>.
- May 1, Fri. - Three-week grade checks for the ineligible students.
- May 1 – May 8 - Waiting period.
- May 8, Fri. - Ineligible students who passed all subjects as of May 1<sup>st</sup> become eligible at the end of the school day.
- May 28, Thurs. - Last day of school. End of the fourth grading period. Students with the correct number of credits will be eligible when school begins in the fall. Those needing additional credits may earn these during the summer.
